APPLICANT: Hoot-N-Hollar (Chanel Pentecost)
LOCATION: 219 Trenton St.
REQUEST: Requesting Certificate of Appropriateness for signage and an awning (gray or black), also paint the top outside to match in Cottonport Historic District.
